

The Balance of Payments and International Investment Position (BoP/IIP) Estimates of Niue (which in

brief) highlights the accounting record of all monetary transactions between Niue and the rest of the

world for the period up to ending June 2017/18.

This compilation of the BoP/IIP estimates of Niue was compiled with the guidelines of the IMF BPM6

Framework and SNA 2008.

In this release there has been some improvements in the availability of data for this compilation hence

most of the figures from previous years have been revised accordingly. However, there were still some

gabs in the data used (some of them were still not all available at the time of compilation). We

endeavour to revise these data in the future compilations. Hence, we would like to advise users to use

it with cautious and if in doubt please get in touch with us.






Graph 1. Current account + Capital account (Net Lending/Borrowing)
