Statistics Niue is very happy to put out this statistical release of the Balance of Payments and International Investment Position (BoP/IIP) Estimates of Niue which in brief highlights the accounting record of all monetary transactions between Niue and the rest of the world for the period of 2006/07 to 2009/10.

The compilation of BoP estimates for Niue was ceased way back in 2001 and for the first time after ten years the Statistics Niue office with the great assistance from the Pacific Financial Technical Assistance Centre of the International Monetary Fund (PFTAC/IMF) provided by Michael Andrews saw this revival process made possible. Statistics Niue is most grateful. Fakaaue lahi.

This compilation of the BoP/IIP estimates of Niue was compiled with the guidelines of the IMF BPM6 Framework.

Please note that because this compilation is still in its early stages of revival, there were still a lot of gabs in the data used as some of them were not all available at the time of compilation and hence released as preliminaries. 


