We are pleased to present this statistical release, *Balance of Payments and International Investment Position (BoP/IIP) Estimates of Niue*, which highlight the accounting record of all monetary transactions between Niue and the rest of the world for the period ending 30 June 2025. This compilation follows the guidelines of the IMF's BPM6 Framework and the 2008 SNA.

This release incorporates improved data availability, resulting in revisions to previously published figures. As with all Balance of Payments statistics, the estimates remain provisional and may be updated as new administrative data, financial records, partner-country information, and other external sources become available. The Niue Statistics Office (NSO) continuously reviews and update its BoP series to reflect improvements in data availability, classifications, and methodology in line with IMF BPM6 standards.

Users are advised to interpret the estimates with care and contact the NSO for clarification where needed. All BoP and International Investment Position (IIP) estimates in this publication are provisional. Figures may be revised as new administrative data, financial records, partner-country information, and other external sources become available.

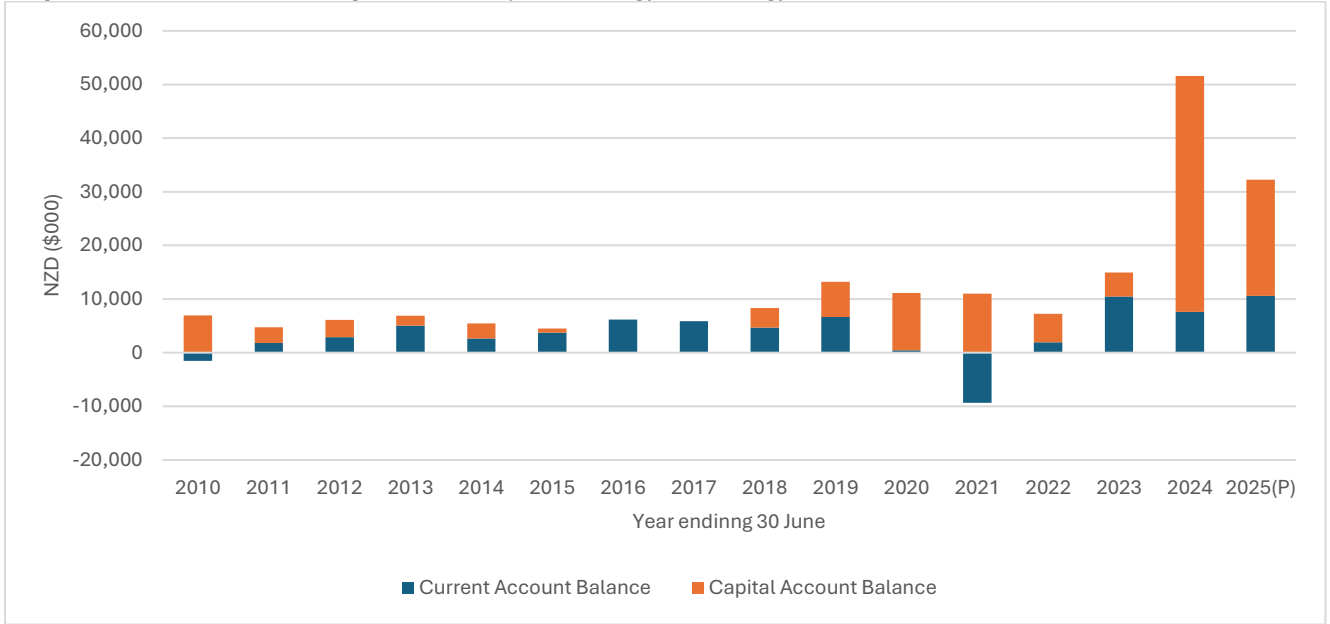

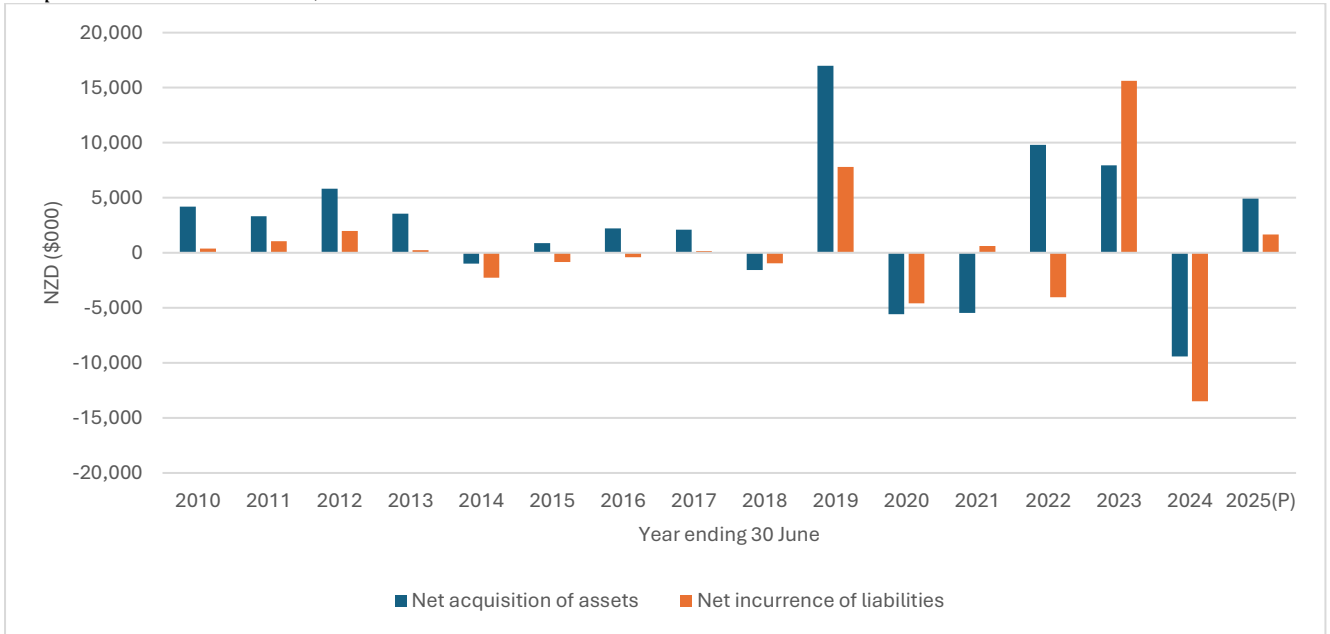

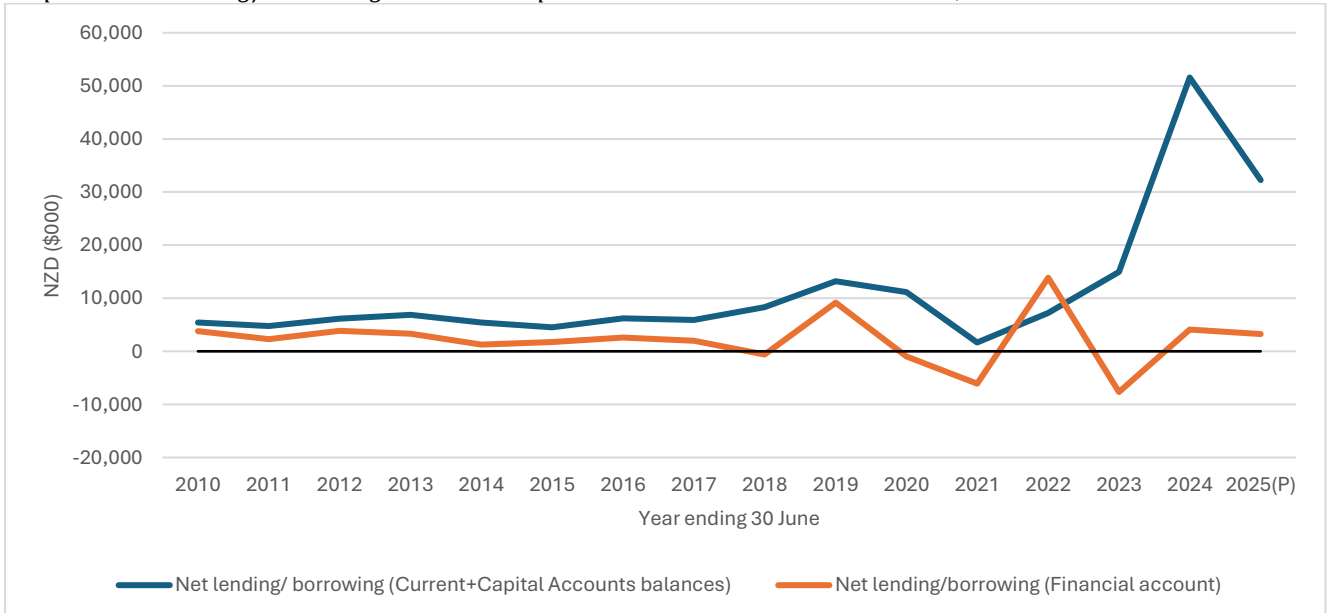
Graph 1.1 Current account + Capital account (Net Lending/Borrowing), 2010 – 2025
