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INTRODUCTION

We are very happy to put out this statistical release – Niue Consumer Price Index (CPI) – for the first quarter of 2026 ending 31st March.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures change in the prices of goods and services that households consume. It was originally introduced to provide a measure of the changes in the living costs faced by workers, so that wages could be related to the changing levels of prices. However, over the years CPI have widened its scope and is now widely used as a macroeconomic indicator of inflation. It has become a key statistic for the purpose of economic policymaking.

Inflation is ‘imported’ when domestic prices increase due to an increase in the price of imports. Imported inflation may result directly from increases in the price of goods imported for resale, or indirectly from increases in the price of imported fuels, materials, and components necessary for domestic production.
