Of Niue's 1,564 usual residents, 92 (5.9%) were living in Lakepa on Census Night.

This was an **INCREASE** of 14 residents compared to the 2017 Census.

This ranked Lakepa **6<sup>th</sup>** in terms of population amongst Niue's 14 villages.
